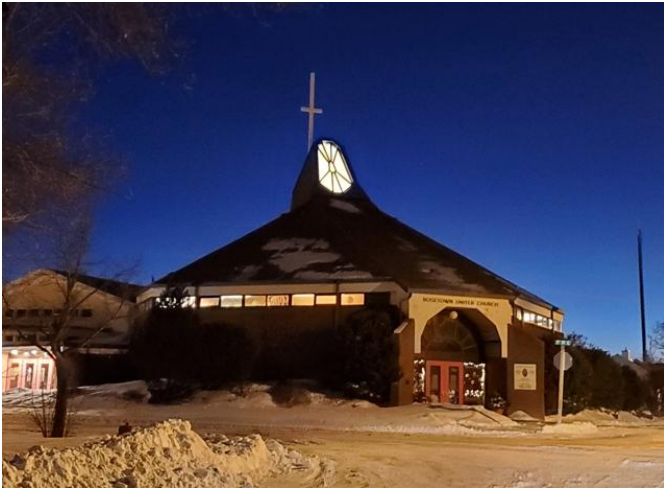


A Lenten Devotional
